Storage: Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline, pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02%

sodium azide and 50% glycerol. Store at -20 °C. Stable for 12 months from

date of receipt.

Purification: The antiserum was purified by peptide affinity chromatography using

SulfoLinkTM Coupling Resin (Thermo Fisher Scientific).

Immunogen: A synthesized peptide derived from human Granzyme B/H, corresponding

to a region within N-terminal amino acids.

Description: GZMB This enzyme is necessary for target cell lysis in cell-mediated

immune responses. It cleaves after Asp. Seems to be linked to an activation cascade of caspases (aspartate-specific cysteine proteases) responsible for apoptosis execution. Cleaves caspase-3, -7, -9 and 10 to give rise to active enzymes mediating apoptosis. Belongs to the peptidase S1 family.

Granzyme subfamily. Induced by staphylococcal enterotoxin A (SEA) in

peripheral blood leukocytes.

AF0175 at 1/100 staining Human normal tissues adjacent to liver cancer by IHC-P. The sample was formaldehyde fixed and a heat mediated antigen retrieval step in citrate buffer was performed. The sample was then blocked and incubated with the primary Ab at 4°C overnight. An HRP conjugated anti-Rabbit Ab was used as the secondary Ab.



<code>TMPORTANT:</code> For western blot, incubate membrane with diluted primary Ab in 5% w/v milk , 1% TBS, 0.1% Tween®20 at 4°C with gentle shaking, overnight.

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
