


Phospho-Calcium Sensing Receptor (Thr888) Ab

Reactivity:	Human,Mouse,Rat	
Storage:	Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline , pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol. Store at -20 $^\circ$ C. Stable for 12 months from date of receipt.	
Purification:	The Ab is from purified rabbit serum by affinity purification via sequential chromatography on phospho-peptide and non-phospho-peptide affinity columns.	
Immunogen:	A synthesized peptide derived from human Calcium Sensing Receptor around the phosphorylation site of Thr888.	
Uniprot:	P41180	
Description:	The calcium-sensing receptor (CASR) functions as a sensor for parathyroid and kidney to determine the extracellular calcium concentration and thus helps to maintain a stable calcium concentration.	



AF3296 staining Hela cells by ICC/IF. Cells were fixed with PFA and permeabilized in 0.1% saponin prior to blocking in 10% serum for 45 minutes at 37°C. The primary Ab was diluted 1/400 and incubated with the sample for 1 hour at 37°C. A Alexa Fluor 594 conjugated goat polyclonal to rabbit IgG (H+L), diluted 1/600 was used as secondary Ab.

<code>IMPORTANT:</code> For western blot, incubate membrane with diluted primary Ab in 5% w/v milk , 1X TBS, 0.1% Tween®20 at 4°C with gentle shaking, overnight.

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
