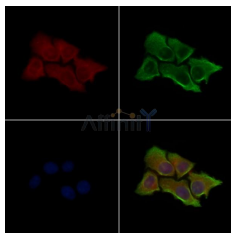


Phospho-CaMKII alpha (Ser331) Ab

Application:	IF/ICC 1:100-1:500 *The optimal dilutions should be determined by the end user.
Reactivity:	Human, Mouse, Rat
Storage:	Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline, pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol. Store at -20 °C. Stable for 12 months from date of receipt.
Purification:	The Ab is from purified rabbit serum by affinity purification via sequential chromatography on phospho-peptide and non-phospho-peptide affinity columns.
Immunogen:	A synthesized peptide derived from human CaMK2 alpha around the phosphorylation site of Ser331.
Uniprot:	Q9UQM7



AF3793 staining HepG2 cells (serum starvation treatment) by IF/ICC. The samples were fixed with PFA and permeabilized in 0.1% Triton X-100, then blocked in 10% serum for 45 minutes at 25°C. Samples were then incubated with primary Ab (AF3793) and mouse anti-beta tubulin Ab (T0023) for 1 hour at 37°C. An AlexaFluor594 conjugated goat anti-rabbit IgG (H+L) Ab (Red) and an AlexaFluor488 conjugated goat anti-mouse IgG (H+L) Ab (Green) were used as the secondary Ab. The nuclear counter stain is DAPI (blue).
